

Provisioning Process for SCORM Packages

The following steps illustrate the procedure for delivering SCORM packages by soluzione after order confirmation: the delivery process, the contents of the SCORM packages, and the customer's responsibilities.

Services provided by soluzione:

- SCORM packages can be provided in **SCORM versions 1.2 and 2004 (3rd Edition)**.
- Upon delivery, **course content** (learning content for the corresponding courses) and tests (to check whether the learning content has been understood) are delivered as separate packages.
- The **test results** are transmitted to the customer's LMS using the following parameters:

Status of SCORM 1.2 to LMS:

- Status "cmi.core.lesson_status": completed, incomplete, failed, passed, not attempted

Status of SCORM 2004 3rd Edition to LMS:

- Status "cmi.completion_status": incomplete, completed, not attempted, unknown
- Status "cmi.success_status": passed, failed, unknown

Customer tasks:

- It is the customer's responsibility to **call up the test** after the course or to ask the user to call up the test. This must be implemented using the functions of the LMS used.
- Likewise, the **creation of certificates** or confirmations of successful completion of a course, including tests, is the responsibility of the customer.
- soluzione does not provide **support** for the functions of the **LMS** used in each case.
